By consensus, a goal was set to post the application for library director on or near November 24, 2025, with a deadline of January 16, 2026. Interviews will follow the week of January 19 – 23, 2026. The job posting and a job description will be available on library websites, with printed copies at the library, at City Hall, and in local media.
