Spirit Lake Library Board Meeting

October 7, 2024

- An additional staff member has been hired. With staff health concerns and family deaths, library staffing has been challenging.

New Business:

- Christenson presented an update on the Director search. Two applications have been received.
- Cindy updated the board on the status of Wahpeton City Council's decisions.

- The county-wide library staff in-service will be held at the Spirit Lake Library October 30 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Reminder: the library will be closed during those hours, opening at 1:00 that day.
- Countywide trustee training will be November 12 at the Milford Library.

Policy Reviews:
