With its low vision electronic magnifiers, many color select options are available for increased contrast. Depending on your eye condition, certain text and background color combinations allow for ease of reading. One of the color select options is black and white. It will convert anything you are viewing to a black and white image for increased contrast.

The Merlin can also be used to magnify other things besides books: mail, maps, needlework, crafts, crossword puzzles, photographs, recipes, coins, etc. The possibilities are almost endless!
