

Membership Types

Provisional – new local property owner or resident (Spirit Lake, Orleans, Okoboji, West Okoboji, rural Dickinson County)

- May check out 10 items at a time
- Full access to digital resources
- If account is in good standing after 3 months, will renew to Residential

Residential – local property owner or resident (Spirit Lake, Orleans, Okoboji, West Okoboji, rural Dickinson County)

- May check out 40 items at a time (DVDs – limit 10)
- Full access to digital resources
- Inter-Library Loan (ILL) services available (\$2 per item)

Open Access – resident outside of Spirit Lake & contracting cities (Spirit Lake, Orleans, Okoboji, West Okoboji, and rural Dickinson County)

- May check out 5 items at a time
- May check out ONLY books, audio books, DVDs and magazines
- No Learning Resource Kits
- No access to digital resources (including Libby & Hoopla)

Group Home – client of residential facility

- May check out 5 items at a time
- No Learning Resource Kits or electronic devices

The resources that are available to only our Provisional and Residential Patrons are as follows: A to Z World Travel, BookFlix, Hoopla, Libby, Transparent Languages, and Tumble Books. To use these, you will need to sign in and/or create an account. Provisional and Residential Patrons are those who live within the city limits of Spirit Lake or live where library services are contracted and paid for. Those contracting cities/areas are Okoboji, Orleans, rural Dickinson County, West Okoboji, and Wahpeton. The digital resources listed above are paid for either by the Friends of the Spirit Lake Public Library or the library itself, which is funded by the taxpayers of Spirit Lake and the contracting cities.
